

Lewis Harold, Ninety Six, Reported Missing

Washington, Sept. 25. —(AP)—The Navy announced today 122 casualties, including 4 dead, 1 wounded and 117 missing. In addition, one man previously listed as missing now is reported to be dead.

This brings to 29,995 the total of Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard casualties reported to next of kin since December 7, 1941. The grand total includes 10,566 dead, 5,267 wounded, 10,017 missing and 4,145 prisoners of war.
