



BARRACKS BECOMES MEMORIAL TO SC INFANTEYMAN: This barracks at Fort Benning, Ga., has been dedicated as a permanent memorial to 2nd Lieut. Ralph Hardee who was killed during World War II service in France on August 9, 1944. He was the son of Mrs. Furman Hardee of Conway and the late Col. Furman Hardee. Mrs. Hardee received, posthumously, the D.S.C. and two Purple Heart awards made to her son. Lieut. Hardee entered The Citadel in September, 1940, later enlisted at Fort McPherson, Ga., in December, 1941, after the bombing of Pearl Harbor. He was later commissioned at McDill Air Base, sent to Fort Jackson in May, 1942, then served 10 months in Iceland, and 11 months in Ireland.
