8 March. Elizabeth, wife of Charles Barcroft of Old Ford, Middlesex, answers the Ecclesiastical Commissioners. Her husband left his trade in London and went to Virginia in August 1636 when his brother John Barcroft died there in order to collect his debts. She then went to live with her parents at Whitechapel but had no unlawful familiarity with any lewd person. (*CSPCAdd.1*).

24 February. Depositions made on behalf of Ascanius Hickes, vintner of London, re debts of Charles Barcroft, late of London but now living in Virginia. (*LMC*).
